### Gift Card Fundraiser

Support Flagstaff Academy through the purchase of retail gift cards. Simply buy a gift card to a retailer you frequent, and Flagstaff will earn a percentage. To get started and place an order, sign up here: <https://www.shopwithscrip.com/getstarted/register.aspx>. Enter the Flagstaff Academy Enrollment Code C3LC38771L353. You do not have to set up a Presto-Pay account at this time. (PrestoPay takes 2-3 days to set up. It also allows you to pay directly from your checking account on future orders.) After you have set up your Shop With Scrip account, click on "Order Scrip" (blue tab at the top). If you know what you want, the easiest way to order is to select "ExpressAdd" (near the top with a blue + next to it). Just start typing the merchant name and a list of matches come up. Highlight the merchant then enter the quantity of cards. You can also browse by category (which appears after you click on "Order Scrip"). After you complete your order, make note of the amount due and turn in a check (with "RETAIL SCRIP" in the memo area) to the front desk of the school. There is no need to print anything to turn in with your check. You can place your order at any time. Payment is due by 4 PM on Wednesday, January 14<sup>th</sup>.
